Goals and Expectations

Students will:

1. Have a good understanding of and be able to define and describe a biblical worldview.
2. Analyze different ideologies and philosophies based on eight dilemmas of being human.
3. Construct, articulate, and defend their worldview.

Summer Reading with specific assignments.

- *Bearing God's Name: Why Sinai Still Matters*, by Joy Carmen Imes (entire book)
 - *We will discuss the book on Day 1 of class, but the questions will not be due until the first class of Quarter 2. You are free to turn them in when you are finished.*
